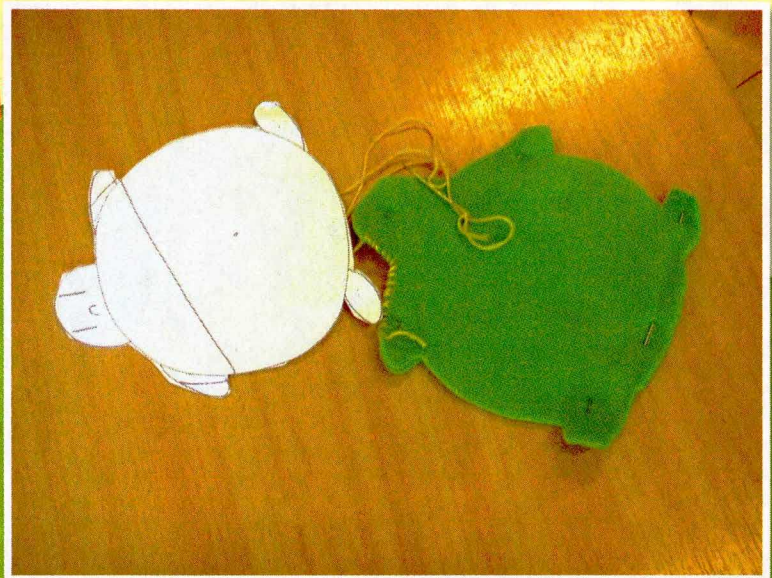
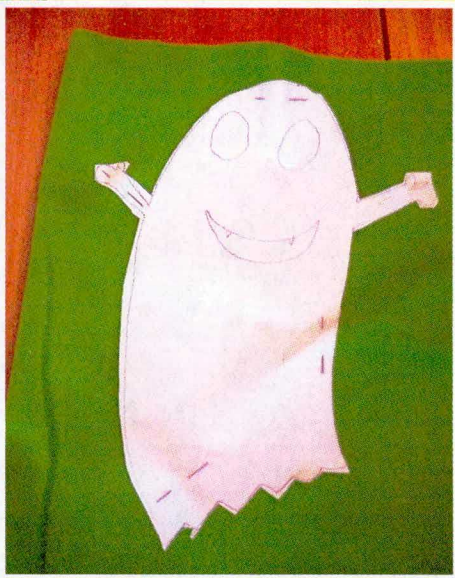
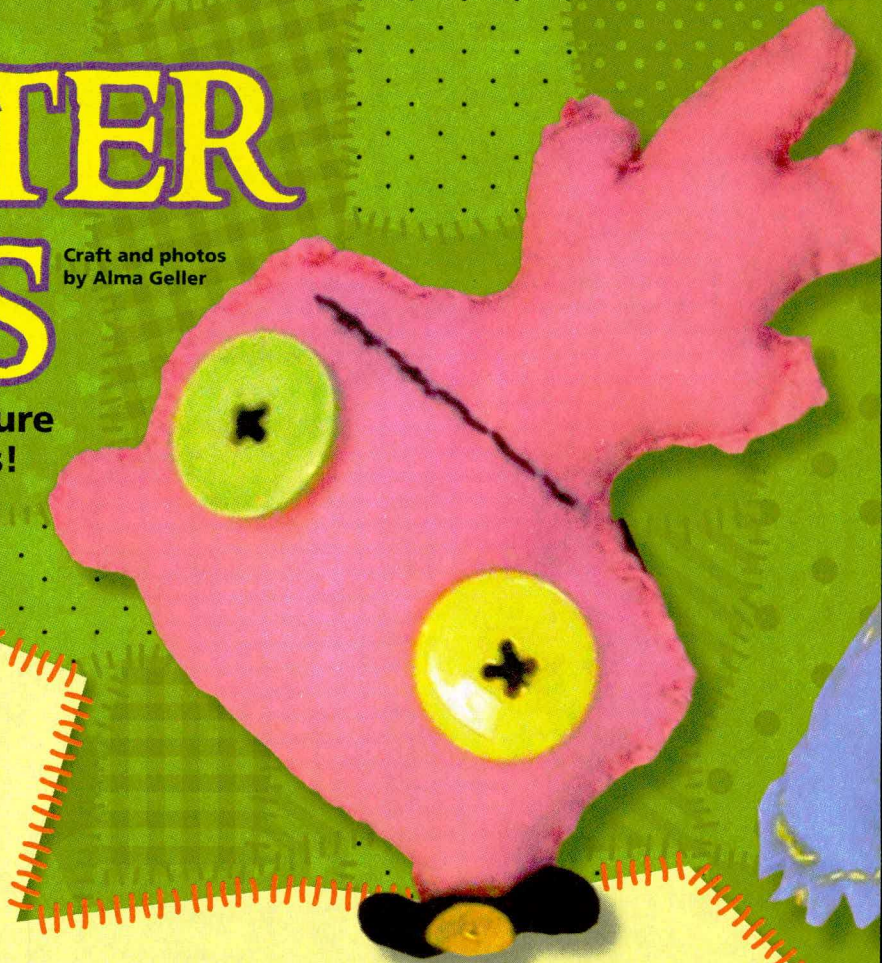
Create a creepy creature  
with these easy steps!

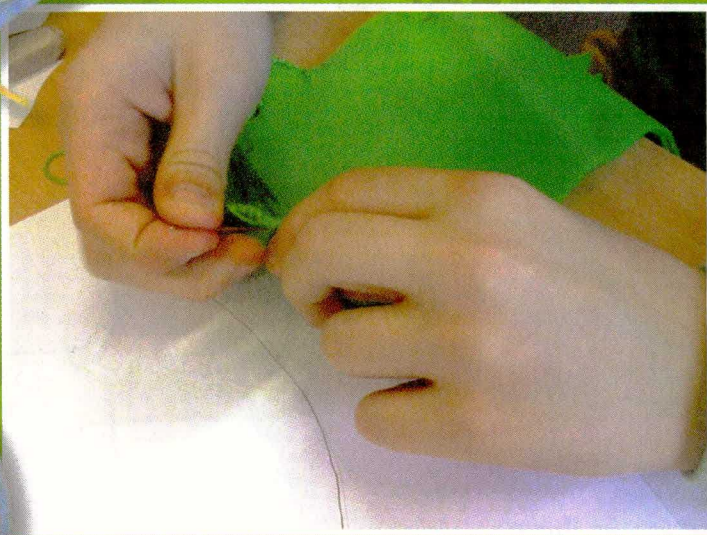
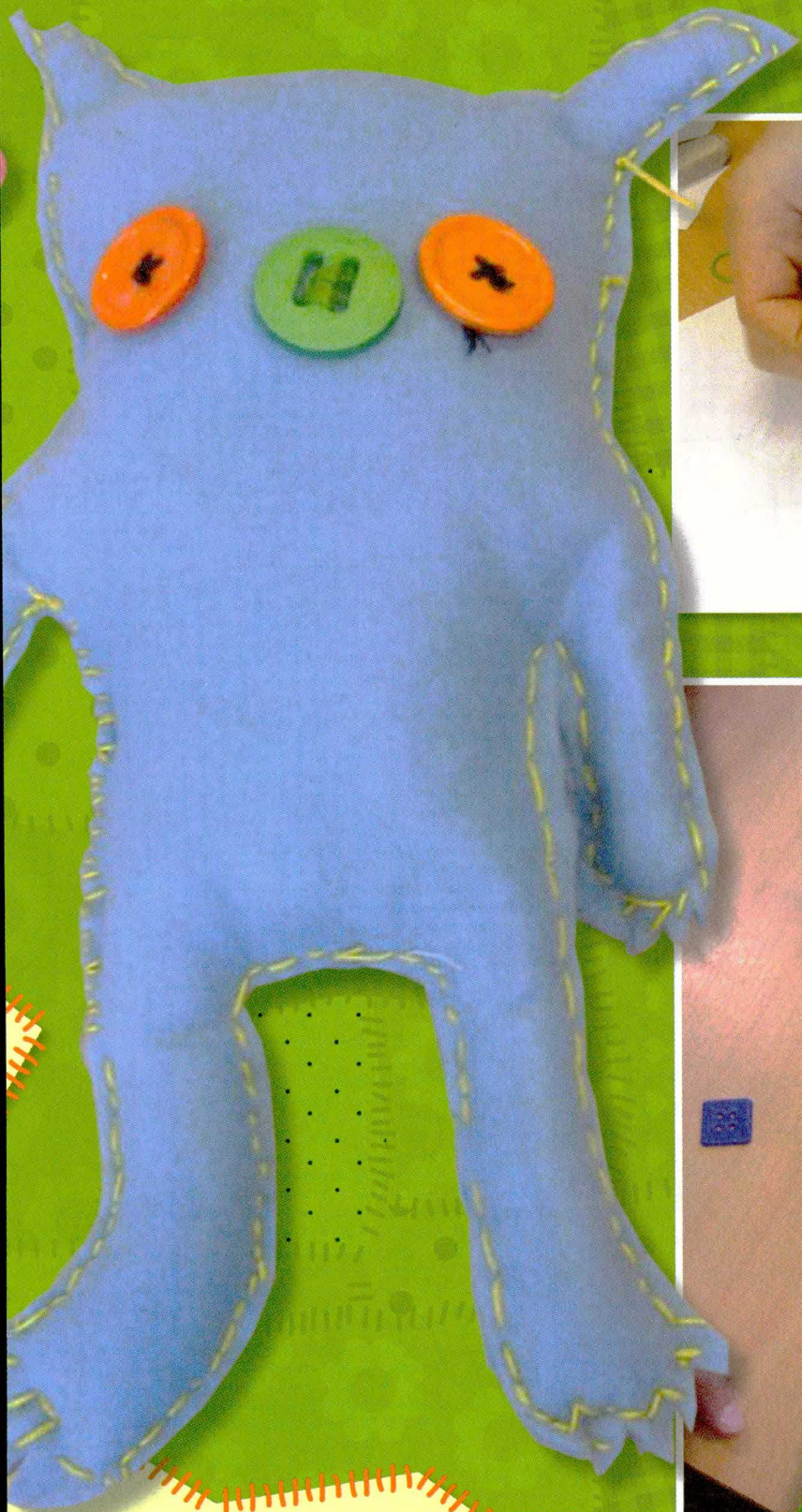
## WHAT YOU NEED

- Pencil
- Paper
- Scissors
- Felt
- Pins
- Needle
- Thread
- Stuffing
- Buttons

## WHAT YOU DO

1. Draw a monster on a piece of paper.
2. Cut out the monster to use as a pattern.
3. Lay the monster pattern on top of 2 pieces of felt. Pin the pattern and felt pieces together.
4. Cut the pattern from the felt. Remove the pins.
5. Pin the 2 monster-shaped felt pieces together. With the needle and thread, sew the pieces together along the edges. Leave an opening near the head for stuffing. Remove the pins.
6. Fill the monster with stuffing. Use a pencil to push stuffing into the hard-to-reach areas.





**7.** With help from your grown-up, sew a face on the monster. Use thread or buttons for the eyes, nose, and mouth.

**8.** Sew the opening closed.
