For 45 years the Friends of the Library have raised funds to help the library provide a wide range of opportunities for lifelong learning, enrichment, and enjoyment for everyone in the community. On December 31, 2010, 368 individuals, families, and businesses were members of the Friends of the Library. In addition, Friends and community members made 257 donations to the Campaign for Excellence, and 58 general donations to the Friends.

Campaign for Excellence

The Friends initiated the Campaign for Excellence in 2010 with a focus on children. Thanks to the generosity and support of so many people, we exceeded our goal. Including some gifts received in 2011, the Campaign raised a total of \$27,370 to support children's programming and collections, to build the Children's Endowment, and more. Our Library

In 2010 there were 1,085,108 visits to our library (Main Library and Ellettsville Branch) with a circulation of 2,615,926 items. The library provided 2,091 programs to 54,269 attendees and had 88,666 cardholders. The library provided 161,372 hours of public computer use. The Friends of the Library provided materials, prizes, refreshments, and more to enhance patrons' visits to MCPL. The Library was recognized as a "Top Ten Library" in the Hennen American Public Library Ratings.
